The hostile environment – on our streets, today

We have all seen on TV or read in the press how millions of people have been forced from their homes and are often displaced across international borders.

Those that make it to Britain are desperate to make a new life here but so often those hopes are dashed. The government's 'hostile environment' results in many being forced into **destitution**: receiving no state support at all, not permitted to work, homeless, penniless and at risk of exploitation. Unable or too frightened to return to their own countries, they desperately need our help.

The London Churches Refugee Fund makes small grants to drop-in centres, accommodation projects and other charities directly supporting destitute refugees and asylum seekers.

Grants are used mainly for food, bus passes, nappies and hygiene packs and emergency accommodation. We employ no staff but channel donations from churches and individuals to those who are destitute.
